Cost: \$10 per shooter to cover the cost of the shooting bay

Shooting: Target Time Defense [2410 NW South Outer Road Blue Springs MO 64015](http://2410NWSouthOuterRoadBlueSpringsMO64015)

Time: Shooting starts at noon however if you've never shot there before, you will need to watch a 9 minute safety video and fill out a waiver before shooting OR you can go to their website targettimedefense.com/range and watch the video and fill out the waiver on line. You may bring your own ammo, targets etc, no gun shop purchase is required. They do have lots of guns to rent if you don't have one to shoot or you have always wanted to shoot a certain gun or caliber, feel free to rent one. They do have targets, ammo etc to purchase if necessary.

Eating: We will shoot for about an hour or so depending on the number of shooters and then head east on I70 to Wellington MO to Catfish Charlies. It's a fabulous little restaurant that features catfish, shrimp and other seafood however if seafood isn't your thing, they also serve chicken, steaks, burgers and salads.
